PHBA is an all volunteer youth Baseball/Softball league. To encourage volunteer participation we have our League Assistance Fund Fee (LAFF). At sign-ups all families will be required to pay an LAFF deposit, separate from the annual registration fees. The LAFF deposit is Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) per child with a maximum of One-Hundred-Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), two children or more. To have your deposit returned you will need to perform one of the League Volunteer Assignments listed below. Be advised that a League Volunteer Assignment is different and separate from any volunteering you do for your team. Your League Volunteer Commitment is Four (4) hours per child; maximum of Eight (8) for two or more children in the league.

Here is a list of League Volunteer Assignments that will qualify for a return of LAFF deposit Check:
Pre-Season Field Restoration ~ Manager ~ Coach ~ Umpire ~ Team Coordinator ~ League Picture Day ~ League Opening Day ~ League Registration Day ~ Snack Bar ~ Basket Person (Season Field prep & Scorekeeping up to Mgrs discretion) ***You will have a chance to sign-up for any one of these assignments at your team meetings, sometime in late Jan., early February.***

It takes a lot of people volunteering a lot of time to make PHBA work and be successful, and we would prefer **NOT** to retain any LAFF funds. Your time is more valuable to our players than the money. That said, should you prefer not to volunteer, you may buy out your obligation for One-Hundred-Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00) per child, with a maximum of Two-Hundred-Fifty (\$250.00), two children or more. Just sign this form and your obligation is completed.
